Deciduous/Evergreen: Deciduous

Southern Region Container Production

pH: 5-5.5 EC: 0.5-1.5

Hardiness: Zone 5-8

Heat Zone: 8-5

Fertilization Requirements	Medium to high rate of complete controlled release fertilizer. No urea.
Overwintering Practices and Temperatures	Overwintering temperatures generally greater than 20°F. A normal winter will satisfy the chilling requirement.
Light Levels	Part Shade
Water Requirements	Keep plants moist, but do not over water plants when they are young.
Planting Season	Planting occurs in the spring after the danger of frost has passed.
Propagation Method and Notes	Tissue Culture
Pest/Disease Management	When water late in the day, leaf spots appear. Watch for flea beetles.
PGR Application	No experience with PGRs
Flowers on new or old wood	Blooms on new wood.
Special Notes	Keep plants properly spaced. Treat with Subdue Maxx in late February to protect against any frost cracks that occur during winter. Treat with fungicide after pruning. It is very important not to prune this plant after May 1st. Needs to be pruned in April. Plants respond very poorly to pruning in the heat.

Estimated Finishing Times

	8" container	#3 container
Liner	Pot using a 2 1/2" plug in early spring. Plants will finish in August.	With 8" upshift, shift plants in August to allow root formation before winter.

pH: 5.5-6 EC: 1-2

Hardiness: Zone 5-8

Fertilization Requirements	8 month (18-6-11) incorp at time of planting
Overwintering Practices and Temperatures	Plants are consolidated and cover with 6 mil poly. Temperatures range from 22-27°F.
Light Levels	Full Sun
Water Requirements	Medium water requirments. Do not allow plants to get too wet.
Planting Season	Planting occurs in spring.
Propagation Method and Notes	Tissue culture.
Pest/Disease Management	Bacterial leaf spot has been observed.
PGR Application	No experience with PGRs
Flowers on new or old wood	Blooms on new wood.

Liner	#3 container
Plug (38 plug)	Finish in 1 year with a flush.
Plug (Quart)	Finish in 6 months.
