Deciduous/Evergreen: Evergreen (in mild winters)

Southern Region Container Production

pH: 5-6 **EC:** 0.5-2.0

Hardiness: Zone 6-9

Heat Zone: 9-6

Fertilization Requirements	Medium to high rate of controlled release fertilizer.
Overwintering Practices and Temperatures	Overwinter outside. Overwintering temperatures generally greater than 20°F when fully dormant.
Light Levels	Full sun.
Water Requirements	Moist. Apply an inch of water every day.
Planting Season	Planting occurs any time of year.
Propagation Method and Notes	3000 ppm IBA applied to softwood cuttings in spring. Slow to root and requires a flush to survive winter. Do not over water can get root rot. Plugs require moderate to low levels of fertilizer after flush. Plant plugs in spring.
Pest/Disease Management	Flea beetles have been observed.
PGR Application	No experience with PGRs.
Flowers on new or old wood	Blooms on old wood.
Special Notes	Responds well to pruning.
Vernalization	Yes

Liner	8" container	#3 container
Plug 2 1/2"	Pot using a 2 1/2" plug. Plants will finish in 1 growing season.	Plants will finish in 2 growing seasons.
Upshift		Pot using 8" ct upshift, plants will finish in 4 to 5 months, depending on actual growing time.
