Tawara is partially self-fruitful, but will produce more pears if planted with other cultivars. European or Asian pears, such as Seckle, Bosc or Bartlett can be used for pollination.

Discovered by Jeanne and Jim Matsuda of Park Creek Nursery, Tawara Asian Pear produces excellent fruit that can be eaten fresh or canned.
