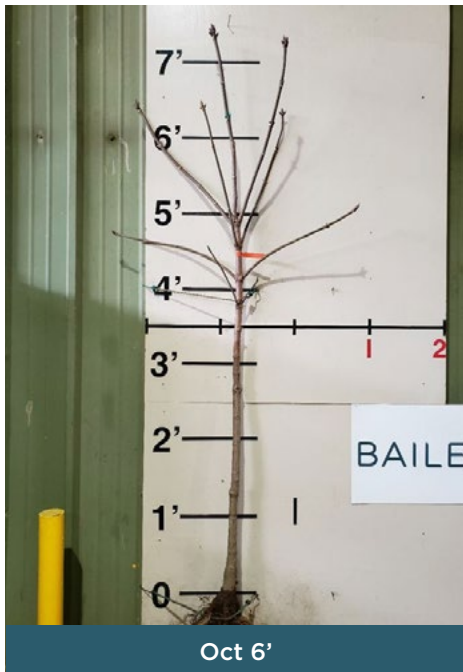

The lustrous foliage is more resistant to blotch, leaf scorch, and subsequent early defoliation than the species. This native tree reputedly produces very little fruit for minimal litter.
