### FlowerFull® Smooth Hydrangea

*Hydrangea arborescens* 'BAIful' PP35,612 CPBRAf

- Stronger, upright stems that resist flopping
- Exceptional bloom density, 2-3x more flowers
- A lush, refined habit for a modern landscape

**Compared to species:** Traditional *Hydrangea arborescens* often struggle with weak stems that flop under the weight of their blooms, frustrating gardeners who want tidy, upright plants. While the classics can still offer a respectable flower show, they frequently lose their shape as the season wears on. FlowerFull® solves this issue with sturdy, supportive stems and delivers more blooms.



### Fiber Optics™ Buttonbush

*Cephalanthus occidentalis* 'Bailoptics' PP29,475 CPBR6180

- Compact, rounded habit ideal for smaller landscapes or rain gardens
- Has finer foliage and texture for a more refined look
- Pollinator magnet with bright white, spherical blooms

**Compared to species:** Native buttonbush often grow large and rangy, making it harder to use in tight or formal spaces. Fiber Optics™ retains the ecological benefits such as pollinator support and moisture tolerance. In addition, it offers a smaller, more home landscape-friendly form.



### Fireside® Ninebark

*Physocarpus opulifolius* 'UMNHarpell' PP30,792 CPBR4765

- Deep burgundy foliage that holds its color throughout the season
- Enhanced resistance to powdery mildew for cleaner, healthier leaves
- Dense, upright habit with striking exfoliating bark for winter interest

**Compared to species:** Traditional ninebark varieties may lose foliage color over time and are often susceptible to foliar diseases. Fireside® offers bold color, better disease resilience especially with powdery mildew, and four-season appeal in a well-structured form. ### Cinnamon Girl<sup>®</sup> Distylium

*Distylium* 'PIIDIST-V' PP27,631 CPBR6041

- Dense, mounding habit with soft, bluish evergreen foliage that emerges a bronze-pink hue
- Cold-hardy and heat-tolerant, built for year-round resilience
- A resilient, low-maintenance boxwood alternative

**Alternative to Warm-Climate Evergreen Shrubs:** While boxwood, cherry laurel, and other disease or insect-susceptible evergreen have been long-standing favorites, it can be vulnerable to blight and environmental stress. Cinnamon Girl<sup>®</sup> Distylium offers a durable, disease-resistant alternative with evergreen structure offering a fresh solution for challenging environmental concerns.



### Straight & Narrow<sup>®</sup> Japanese Holly

*Ilex crenata* 'PIIIC-I' PP29,578

- Tight, columnar habit perfect for narrow beds, formal hedges, or vertical accents
- Dense branching and glossy evergreen leaves
- Holds its shape with minimal pruning

**Alternative to 'Sky Pencil':** 'Sky Pencil' Holly starts out with a tidy, upright form, but as it matures, it often splays outward, losing the strong vertical habit gardeners expect. Straight & Narrow<sup>®</sup> Japanese Holly solves that with a tighter, more durable structure that holds its shape beautifully over time. It offers a dependable columnar form, improved hardiness, and year-round visual interest.



### Jade Parade<sup>®</sup> Sand Cherry

*Prunus pumila* 'UCONNPP002' PP33,014

- Low, spreading form with uniform growth and excellent coverage
- Rich fall color in shades of red and orange
- Tough, adaptable, and provides excellent erosion control and weed suppression

**Compared to 'Gro-Low' Sumac:** 'Gro-Low' has long been a go-to groundcover for tough sites, but it often grows unevenly, with open centers, unpredictable spread, and occasional legginess. Jade Parade<sup>®</sup> improves on every front. It offers a tidier, more refined appearance with consistent coverage, richer fall color, and dependable vigor. It's everything people love about 'Gro-Low', but with more reliable performance and stronger landscape aesthetics.
