



## BLUSHING BRIDE REBLOMING HYDRANGEA

*Hydrangea macrophylla* 'Blushing Bride' PP17,169

Shape: Upright, rounded

Exposure: Morning Sun/Afternoon Shade

'Blushing Bride' has big round clusters of pure white, semi-double florets, which mature to blush pink or Carolina blue, depending on soil pH. Internodes between the leaves are shorter than on the The Original, making it more compact and stronger stemmed. Like the other Endless Summer<sup>®</sup> varieties, 'Blushing Bride' blooms on old and new growth and is remarkably mildew resistant. Long a favorite in Europe, 'Blushing Bride' is excellent for cut flowers and for blending louder colors in the garden. (CPBR3403)
