

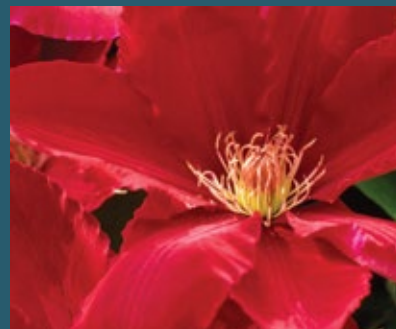
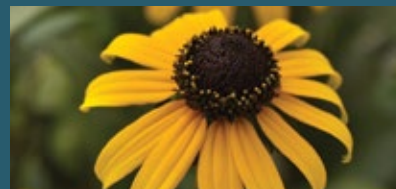

- Advancement in pink smooth hydrangeas for growers, retail, and landscape
- Abundant ruby pink blooms age to parchment pink
- Strong stems and clean foliage ensure reliable performance

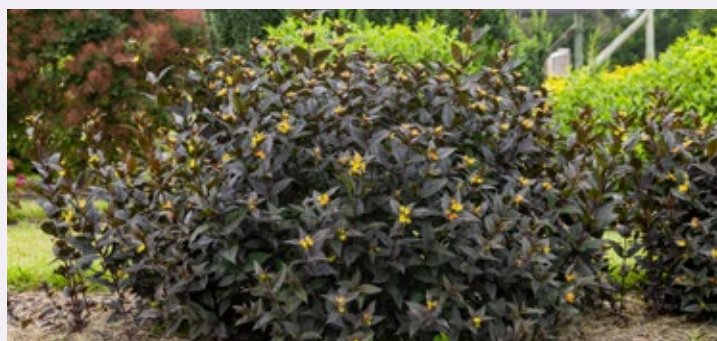
## Dark Mode™ Diervilla

*Diervilla x splendens* 'Baildiertwo' PPAF

- Dark purple-black foliage holds its color reliably all season
- Recurrent yellow blooms add contrast and pollinator interest
- Thrives in full sun to part shade and tolerates drought and wet soils

*Diervilla x splendens* 'Baildierone' PPAF

- Apricot new growth matures to chartreuse, then orange and red in fall
- Classic yellow blooms appear in June with dependable seasonal rebloom
- A deer-resistant variety that is tolerant of both drought and wet soils

## Fire Light Tidbit® Panicle Hydrangea

*Hydrangea paniculata 'SMNHPK' PP32,512*

- Flowers go from white to rich, saturated tones of pink and red as they age
- Has strong blooming ability, with dozens of panicle flowers on strong stems
- One of the smallest panicle hydrangeas that matures at just 2-3'

## Gray Spicebush

*Lindera angustifolia*

- Great for woodland or meadow settings as a hedge or shrub border
- Leaves turn tan to brown in fall and persist into winter

- Features loads of berries that change from green to shades of pink and blue
- Has good berry production even without another pollinator nearby
- Showy, glossy leaves change to incredible dark maroon-red in autumn

## Fall In Love® Sweetly Anemone

*Anemone hupahensis* 'Sweetly' PP31,089

- Produces rich, semi-double rose-pink flowers in early fall
- Semi-double flowers are produced above a large mound of dark green foliage
- Late to rise in spring, use as a cover for the fading spring bulb foliage

## Visions in White Delight Astilbe

*Astilbe chinensis* 'Visions in White Delight' PPAF

- The dense, fragrant, creamy-white flowers attract pollinators
- A compact, robust, and drought tolerant perennial
- Deer resistance makes this a great choice for woodland gardens

### American Goldfinch False Indigo

*Baptisia* 'American Goldfinch' PP30,478

- Gorgeous, golden yellow flower spikes rise up above its wide habit
- A big, bold, floriferous native cultivar
- Perfect for filling in large spaces or mass plantings in landscapes

- Features a combination of indigo blue flowers and golden yellow foliage
- A long-lived perennial that creates a bright focal point in the landscape
- Use in meadow plantings, as a backdrop in borders, or as a specimen

- Golden-orange flowers with yellow tips bloom earlier than other varieties
- An excellent choice for drought tolerance and to attract pollinators
- Grows uniformly with a compact habit

## SpinTop® Orange Halo Gaillardia

*Gaillardia 'Bargaispinor' PP29,205*

- Blooming until fall, the orange blooms are yellow tipped with a deep eye
- A drought-tolerant perennial that is also attractive to pollinators
- Long lasting color makes it perfect for containers

## Ice Dance Sedge

*Carex morrowii 'Ice Dance'*

- Foliage is vivid deep-green with a creamy-white margin
- Evergreen in mild areas and a semi-evergreen in cold areas
- Use as a groundcover or in containers for a fun, funky look

## LaDiva Spirit Purple Blue Lavender

*Lavandula angustifolia 'Purple Blue'*

- Heavily branched stems are covered with deep purple, fragrant flowers
- Is both deer resistant and pollinator friendly
- A great sun-loving, drought-tolerant plant

### Goldblitz Black Eyed Susan

*Rudbeckia fulgida var. sullivantii 'Goldblitz'*

- Nectar-rich golden flowers start early in the season
- Flowers attract pollinators and dried seed heads feed wildlife in winter
- Ideal for a long-lasting cut flowers or for use in dried arrangements

### Candy Stripe Clematis

- Blooms appear in late spring to early summer and again in late summer
- An excellent climber for trellises, arbors, fences, and containers

## Crystal Fountain™ Regal® Clematis

*Clematis* 'EVIpo038'

- Has early, large flowers with lilac-blue petals and a fountain-like center
- A compact vine that is ideal for containers or gardens with limited space
- An incredibly hardy plant that produces flowers even after hard winters

- Reaches 8-10' tall on supports like trellises, arbors, or fences

## Elsa Spath Clematis

*Clematis* 'Elsa Spath'

- Has 6-8" lavender-blue flowers with overlapping petals and red anthers
- This vine is free flowering in late spring with repeat blooms
- A vigorous climber ideal for trellises, arbors, fences, and containers

## H.F. Young Clematis

- The blooms appear in late spring to early summer on last season's wood
- An ideal plant for trellises, fences, arbors, and containers

## Multi Blue Clematis

- Blooms appear in late spring to early summer and again late summer to fall
- An excellent choice for trellises, fences, and arbors

## Pink Champagne Clematis

- This climber blooms in late spring with repeat flowering in late summer
- A compact plant that's ideal for trellises, arbors, fences, and containers

## Major Wheeler Trumpet Vine

- Boasts clusters of orange-red flowers from late spring to summer
- Summer blooms attract pollinators and fall red berries attract wildlife
- Best used as climbing vine or mounded in a woodland garden

EmberGlow™ Seedless Grape

- Highly resistant to powdery mildew, black rot, and *Phomopsis*
- Is ready for harvest in early fall

LumiGlow™ Seedless Grape

- A cold-hardy variety that's resistant to powdery mildew and *Phomopsis*
- Features a flexible harvest window, which fits into multiple schedules

ShadowGlo™ Seedless Grape

- Is cold-climate hardy and resistant to foliar *Phylloxera* and *Phomopsis*
- Is ready for harvest in mid-September, whether by hand or mechanically
